Frequently Asked Questions

What is a waste assessment?

A waste assessment will look at the waste generated by your business, school or organization to determine if you can keep materials from ending up in the garbage. Waste reduction staff will help you identify areas to reduce, reuse or recycle more.

How can a waste assessment help my business?

You can help your business become proactive in reducing waste, helping the environment and possibly saving money on disposal costs by participating in a waste assessment. A waste assessment will help your business build waste wise practices by examining your solid waste stream and working to reduce your garbage.

What can I expect?

- A brief phone call with our waste reduction staff to determine your needs and set up an on-site visit
- An on-site visit and facility walk-through to examine together the variety and volume of material you have that could be taken out of your waste stream
- An assessment of items not already recycled or composted such as pallets, scrap metal, plastics, Styrofoam, food waste and yard waste.
- A follow up with ideas and suggestions on how to reduce waste and possibly disposal costs
